- DON'T TELL MANY PEOPLE ABOUT YOUR MEDICATION TYPES.** Keeping your prescription types private may help in preventing unwanted attention to your medications.
- DON'T GIVE MANY PEOPLE ACCESS TO YOUR MEDICATIONS.** Minimize the number of people who help you with your medications.
- KNOW HOW MUCH MEDICATION YOU HAVE.** Do a routine count of your medications on a regular basis to make sure none are missing.
- DISCARD UNUSED MEDICATIONS PROPERLY.** If your treatment with strong medications is complete, properly discard them to reduce their amounts in the home.
- LOCK UP YOUR MEDICATIONS.** Keep your medications locked up.
